This review will shape the future of the ACF National Event & High Performance Sport Strategy Program for 2026 and beyond.

AusCaliTeams

Everything you need to know about the team component of our event.

Notes:

- Entries will be determined at the discretion of the Member States.
- All entries must be endorsed and submitted by their Member State.
- Competitions from Sub-Juniors through to
 Masters will be available.
- Team member limits may be imposed to maintain an equitable competition.



Tier 1

Tier 1 is a showcase of our open/championship participants from Australia. States may enter up to two teams in each age-group.



Tier 2

Tier 2 serves as a closed competition. Its primary goal is to create an equitable playing field for all participants to perform on a national stage. States may enter through application only.

AusCaliSDG

The AusCaliSDG Competitions is open to all agegroups from Sub-Juniors to Masters.

Calisthenics and Graceful Solo competitions will also be split into two Tiers to allow a greater number of entries. There will be one Tier for Calisthenic Duo competitions per age group.

Grading for Graceful and Calisthenic Solos will be conducted by a panel of adjudicators. This ensures that competitors are competing with performers of a similar standard, regardless of which Tier their Team may align. Grading will be done by video of the soloist's performance that is to be submitted with entry.

Graceful, Calisthenics Solo, and Calisthenics Duo competitors will be selected by their State criteria. The number of entries for States will be announced early 2025.



AusCaliBilities



AusCaliBilities welcomes to the stage performers with a disability or impairment that poses a barrier to participating in the AusCaliTeams or AusCaliSDG competitions.

Team performances - a minimum of three participants. Teams can include support participants. Solos & Duos also welcome. Entries will be for performance only, no competition.

Entries will be open to all age-groups and all Member States.

AusCaliForum

The AusCaliForum will feature a series of workshops and seminars, offering our community the chance to learn, network, and exchange ideas.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q Are club teams able to enter the AusCaliTeam Competition?

Teams are entered by State
Associations, and it will be up to
individual States how they put their
entries together. Keep an eye out for
your State's comms about this.

What do the Tiers mean?

A Tiers can be thought of as divisions.

For Team competitions - States determine what division they want to enter (noting Tier 2 is by application).

For Graceful & Calisthenic Solos - entry will be graded (via video) by a panel of adjudicators


Q Can anyone enter the AusCaliSDG competition?
